NOTIFICATION

Applications in the prescribed form are invited from eligible research scholars who have successfully completed both the spells of Ph.D. Course Work in approved Research Centres of the University for Registration for the Ph.D Course Work Examination, July/August 2023 to regularise the provisional registration for research leading to the award of Ph.D Degree consequent on implementation of Ph.D Regulations 2016.

CONDITIONS OF ELIGIBILITY:

The Course Work Examination is for 2021 admission scholars. As per U.O No. 3936/AC A10/2021/MGU dtd. 12.08.2021, in the case of part time scholars ,those who had completed both the spells of course work only can apply. Those who were absent/ failed / not qualified in the Examination conducted in October 2022 are also eligible to apply for the Examination.

SCHEME OF EXAMINATION:

1. There are four courses for the examination : -

Course - I	Research Methodology
Course - II	Recent Developments in the Broad Area of the discipline
Course - III	Areas of Research which will include detailed review of
	the current status of scholarship in the area
	(Internal Examination conducted in respective centres).
Course - IV	Research and Publication Ethics

For Courses I, II and IV External Examinations will be conducted directly by the University. For Course - III Internal written Examination will be conducted at the Research Centres under the control of the Research Committee and Head of the Research Centres concerned as notified by the University.

The Supervising Teacher shall prepare the question paper for the Course - III- Internal Written Examination and submit the same in sealed cover to the head of the research centre at least two days before the date of the course - III Examination. The Research Committee of

the research centre shall conduct the examination on the scheduled date, notified by the University, under the supervision of an invigilator and hand over the answer scripts in sealed cover to the supervising teacher of each research scholar for valuation. The Supervising Teacher after valuation of the answer scripts shall hand over the mark lists and the answer scripts to the Head of the Research Centre who shall countersign the mark list and forward the same to the Registrar along with the Internal Marks of Course I, II, III and IV in the prescribed format. The valued answer scripts shall be kept under the custody of the Head of the Institution till the date of publication of results in view of complaints in future.

- **2.** Candidates who have completed the full semester of course work had to appear for all the four courses.
- **3.** Course 1- Research Methodology Examination will be conducted in three Streams ie;
 - i. Science, Applied Science & Engineering Stream
- ii. Social Sciences, Management, Commerce, Law & Behavioural Sciences Stream and
 - iii. Languages Stream
- **4.** The Maximum marks for the written examination (for 2020 Admission onwards) of Course I, Course II, Course III and Course IV will be 50 for each course. A scholar shall obtain minimum of 40% for each course and aggregate minimum of 55% for the successful completion of course work examination. For supplementary candidates there is no change in marks and grading. The grading pattern is as follows:

- **5.** Course Work Examinations will be of three hours duration.

Short answer type Questions - 40 marks

(Answer any 10 out of 12 Questions, each question carries 4 marks)

Part-B

Essay type Questions - - 10 marks

(1 Out of 2 Questions, each question carries 10 marks)
